



Summary of Executive Committee decisions **28/05/2016**

**SLC implements 'Brain Centre'; Galle DCA AGM declared null & void;
SSC and SLC enter into MOU; Augmentation of international stadiums.**

SLC Brain Centre:

The Executive Committee approved in principle a proposal by Chairman of the Cricket Advisory Committee – Mr. Aravinda de Silva to set up a high-tech data collection centre of players.

This unit, which will be for the exclusive use of the National selectors, will be equipped with the most cutting edge technology available in analytics and statistics, enabling the national selectors to evaluate players on an almost real-time basis. The unit will also provide for analysis of opposing teams and individual players.

The project is to be overseen by Mr. de Silva and will call for competitive tenders from local and international companies with the necessary technological and analytical expertise, and is to be set up in the near future.

Galle DCA Annual General Meeting declared null and void:

Following several complaints received by member clubs of irregularity in the procedure of calling for an AGM, Sri Lanka Cricket has found that the notice issued by the Galle DCA is bad in law, and as such has declared null and void the purported AGM held on the 28th May 2016.

A new date for the AGM is proposed for July 2016, and will be called for within the accepted procedure. The AGM will be held at Sri Lanka Cricket headquarters in Colombo.

SLC and SSC enter into MOU:

The Executive Committee unanimously approved a proposal to enter into an MOU with the SSC for the development of the SSC and its facilities. Accordingly a 6 member advisory committee comprised of SLC and SSC officials was appointed to identify and evaluate necessary developmental projects that will enhance the SSC as an International venue.

Augmentation of International Stadiums:

Pallakelle International Cricket Stadium

Upon evaluation of a previously slated move to build Indoor Nets at the Pallakelle International Cricket Stadium at a cost of Rs. 104 Million, The Executive Committee having decided that the said proposal is a superfluous expense at this time have approved instead a renovation and refurbishment proposal of five (5) strips at a cost of Rs. 21 Million.

Rangiri Dambulla International Cricket Stadium

In view of the upcoming Australia tour of Sri Lanka, it has been decided to play two (2) Day-Night games at the Rangiri Dambulla International Cricket Stadium. As such an augmentation of the Floodlighting system has been approved.

Sri Lanka Cricket will call for tenders for the above, and the tender process will be facilitated by M/s, Surath Wickramasinghe Associates.

Purchase of Buses for Team transport:

It has been brought the attention of the Executive Committee that a colossal sum of Rs. 46 Million has been spent on National Team transport alone in the past 3 years. Accordingly it was decided to purchase 2 x 45 seat luxury buses, together with 26 seat bus and 1 x 14 ½ Ft Lorry for the use of the National Team and visiting team.

Sponsorship bids and Tenders are called for the purchase of the above vehicles, and will be purchased subsequent to evaluation.

Nelson Mendis appointed Charge d'affairs Under 19 National Team:

Veteran coach Nelson Mendis has been appointed charge d'affairs of the Under 19 national squad and will oversee preparation and play during the forthcoming tours of England and South Africa.

Mr. Mendis' wealth of experience and knowledge will be an invaluable asset to the youth squad as it prepares itself for the international arena.
